

Were These “Fathers” Right?

Eusebius: “**We should believe the things that are written.** The things that are not written, neither think upon, nor inquire into.” 325 A.D.

Cyril: “Do not simply give faith to me while I am speaking these words to you; you have the proofs of what I say from the Holy Word; for **the security and preservation of our faith are not supported by ingenuity of speech but by the sacred Scriptures.**” 356 A.D.

Robert Sungenis: “Resolved: **The Roman Catholic Magisterium, the Bible, and Apostolic tradition** constitutes the authorities for Christian faith and practice.” 2011 A.D.

The Early “Church Fathers”...

Quoted so freely from the New Testament that, except for a few verses, the entire 27 Books can be accurately reproduced.

Since then, however, “Tradition” has taken over as authority, and the list of people who have believed and practiced a thing takes precedence over any and all Scripture references!

1 Corinthians 14:33:

“For God is *not the author of confusion* but of peace, **as in all the churches of the saints.”**
