50 YEARS' ANNIVERSARY! No, I'm not referring to a celebration of anyone's wedding anniversary. I'm not even alluding to any celebration. The killing of children — even unborn children — is no cause for celebration. Tomorrow (Sunday January 22, 2023) will be the 50th anniversary of the infamous Roe vs. Wade declaration of abortion as a "constitutional right". This day calls for mourning, not for rejoicing over the loss of some 55 million innocent children who have since been subjected to a torturous death. It calls for weeping, not only for the children, but also for the nation. We have since become a nation that has lost its soul.
