



QA: What Does the Bible Say About “Snow”? by [John T Polk II](#)

QUESTION: “What does the Bible say about ‘snow’?”

ANSWER: Though never mentioned when Jesus was born, it represents the purity of a soul who obeys the Gospel of Christ.

1. SNOW IN THE WRONG TIME CANNOT BE GOOD —

Proverbs 26:1: As snow in summer and rain in harvest, So honor is not fitting for a fool.

[Timing is important]

2. SNOW IN THE RIGHT TIME MUST BE GOOD --

Proverbs 25:13: Like the cold of snow in time of harvest Is a faithful messenger to those who send him, For he refreshes the soul of his masters.

3. SNOW HAS GREAT VALUE —

Job 38:22: Have you entered the treasury of snow, Or have you seen the treasury of hail...

4. SO IS EVERYONE WASHED CLEAN BY THE BLOOD OF JESUS CHRIST! —

Isaiah 1:18: "Come now, and let us reason together," Says the LORD, "Though your sins are like scarlet, They shall be as white as snow; Though they are red like crimson, They shall be as wool."

[Once washed, crimson souls become white as snow]

5. MELTED SNOW IS PURE WATER —

Jeremiah 18:14: Will a man leave the snow water of Lebanon, Which comes from the rock of the field? Will the cold flowing waters be forsaken for strange waters?

6. WHY WOULD ANYONE CLEANSED BY JESUS CHRIST LEAVE HIM? —

Isaiah 55:10-11: For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven,

And do not return there, But water the earth,
And make it bring forth and bud,
That it may give seed to the sower
And bread to the eater,
11 So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth;
It shall not return to Me void,
But it shall accomplish what I please,
And it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.”

Psalm 51:7: Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; Wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.

2 Peter 1:3-4: His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

7. NO ONE IS CLEANER THAN WHEN WASHED IN JESUS' BLOOD!

Romans 5:8-9: But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. 9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.

Acts 22:16: And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord.
