2. **LISTENED (no one reacted while he showed them that he had been one of them. Only when he said the Gospel he now preached was for "Gentiles" did prejudices "kick in.")**
 - a. Paul had been a zealous Jew **Acts 22:1-3**
 - b. Paul had persecuted Way **Acts 22:4-5**
 - c. Paul's conversion **Acts 22:6-16**
 - d. God condemned Jews' Hardness **Acts 22:17-20**
 - e. Paul sent to Gentiles **Acts 22:21**
 - f. Jews could take no more **Acts 22:22**
