- (2) "The LORD your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your midst, from your brethren. Him you shall hear" (**Deuteronomy 18:15**). Moses' prophecy was specifically fulfilled only in Jesus Christ.
- (3) Teaching that the Old Testament is only myths and fables denies the truthfulness of Jesus Christ! The Devil denies the Word of God!

## 2-03-2016 Find Jesus In Scripture

Philip found Nathanael and said to him, 'We have found Him of whom Moses in the law, and also the prophets, wrote—Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph' (**John 1:45**).

- (1) The Jews in Jesus' day knew God had predicted a Messiah through the Prophets who had written the Word of God. God would give His New Law through this Messiah, which we call the New Testament. "He takes away the first that He may establish the second" (**Hebrews 10:9**).
- (2) Nothing in the Old Testament predicted any other Prophet, like Jesus, who should be followed. These specific prophecies could not have been fulfilled by anyone but Jesus Christ, not: Abraham, Moses, David, Muhammad, Joseph Smith, Edgar Cayce, or any others who claim God is speaking through them today.

(3) Only "Jesus of Nazareth" is identified in Scripture. Have you found Him? He said, "He who believes and is baptized will be saved" (**Mark 16:16**).
