



Matthew 24:1-3: Then Jesus went out and departed from the temple, and His disciples came up to show Him the buildings of the temple. 2 And Jesus said to them, "Do you not see all these things? Assuredly, I say to you, not one stone shall be left here upon another, that shall not be thrown down." 3 Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately, saying, "Tell us, when will these things be? And what will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?"

- 1. When will Jerusalem be so utterly destroyed?
- 2. What will be "the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?"

Jesus answers the first question in Matthew 24:5-35. There were "signs" pointing to the Destruction of Jerusalem in A.D. 70.

Jesus answers the second question in Matthew 24:36-25:46. There are absolutely NO SIGNS pointing to Jesus' Second Coming! Matthew 24:4 Warns of Mis-Application It is False Doctrine to twist, misapply the "signs" of the one to the other.

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Whose "Last Days" Are They?
