Matthew 19:26: With God **all things** are possible.

Acts 4:32: Now the multitude of those who believed were of one heart and one soul ... they had **all things** in common.

1 Corinthians 14:40: Let **all things** be done decently and in order. (Note: this is discussing specifically the church worship service.)

What does that leave out? Nothing! Knowing that, let's be intent on making every aspect of our worship proper and more heartfelt before the Lord.

Ephesians 1:22: And He put **all things** under His feet.

What does that leave out? Nothing! Knowing that, let's put every part of our lives under Jesus' control.

Ephesians 5:20: Giving thanks always for **all things** to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

What does that leave out? Nothing! Knowing that, let's be more thankful for all the ways God has blessed our lives.

Philippians 2:14: Do **all things** without complaining and disputing.

What does that leave out? Nothing! Knowing that, let's be more pleasant and joyful with our lives.

1 Thessalonians 5:21: Test **all things**; hold fast what is good.

What does that leave out? Nothing! Knowing that, let's make sure that everything we do meets with the approval of Christ.

Titus 2:7: In **all things** showing yourself to be a pattern of good works.

What does that leave out? Nothing! Knowing that, let's remember that we need to be a Christian example in everything that we do.

Hebrews 4:13: **All things** are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.
